Clients are be asked to submit the '**Declaration**' that they are 'Covid Safe' before being accepted for a class.

In order that we can provide you with continuous and ongoing lessons, we are applying a zero tolerance approach to safety.

The teachers will therefore refuse attendance unless **ALL** the requirements are met, so PLEASE come prepared.

For those who do attend, please observe the following specific instructions.

Being on time is critical, so that we can manage the lessons effectively, avoiding cost rises and in the interests of the pupils.


To keep everyone safe on the college site, they are sensibly keeping visitors to a minimum.

This means that our staff will be escorting your children from the carpark to the pool, helping them change safely, and returning them to you at the end of the lesson.

There is no need to find carparking, follow complicated routes, constantly sanitise, wear face coverings or change at poolside.

We will do it all for you and keep your children safe.

All you need to do is look for this sign.



For lessons to run smoothly, it's VERY IMPORTANT that you are ON TIME for your lessons.

So please:

1. Come "Swim Ready" > in your swimming costume and Tracksuit/Onesie.
2. Just bring a towel to dry afterwards.
3. Park in the JUNIOR SCHOOL CARPARK. This is off Chalkers Lane. Please do not use the main car park in front of the school.
4. Look for the sign and our staff will look after your children.
5. Please be there 5 minutes **before** your scheduled start time.
6. Please be there 5 minutes **after** the end of your lesson time.

We really thank you for your cooperation in these difficult times and we hope that things will be back to 'normal' next term.

Meaning of 'Covid Safe'

You (pupil or parent) will be 'Covid Safe' if, in **the 14 days** prior to the start or at any time during the course of the term:

- You have not had a temperature above 37.5 deg. C
- You have not had a "Dry Cough", "Shortness of Breath" or "Chest Pains"
- You (or anyone in your normal 'family unit') have not tested as Covid positive.
- You have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or showing symptoms,
- You have not been abroad OR in any 'risk' environment OR been required to self-isolate or quarantine.
- You have & will comply with all Government guidelines/regulations that have been or are in force.

Please sign the attached declaration and either return it with your Booking Form or bring it with you to the 1st lesson. Thank you.

NOTE: Please be aware that you may be refused attendance if you do not submit this declaration, have a high temperature when tested or in the opinion of the teacher/lifeguard, appear unwell.
